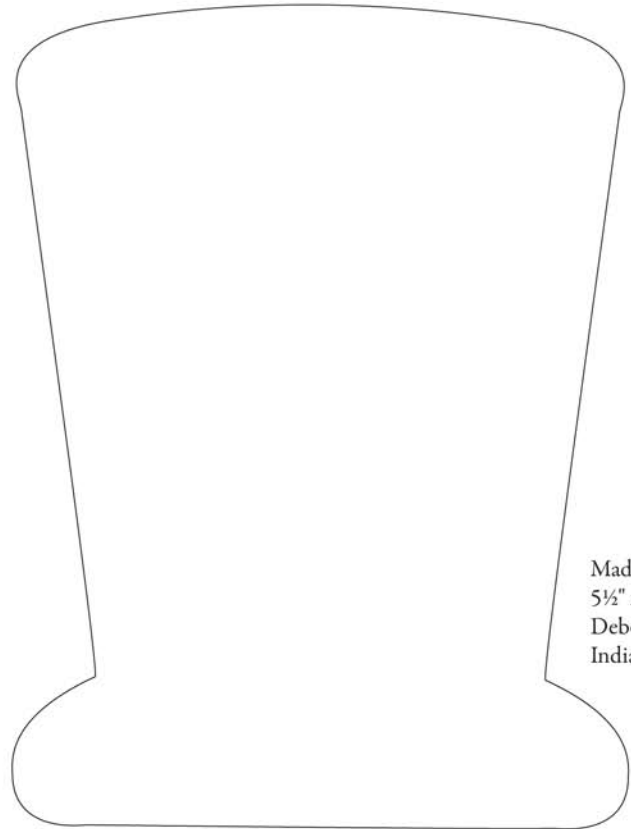
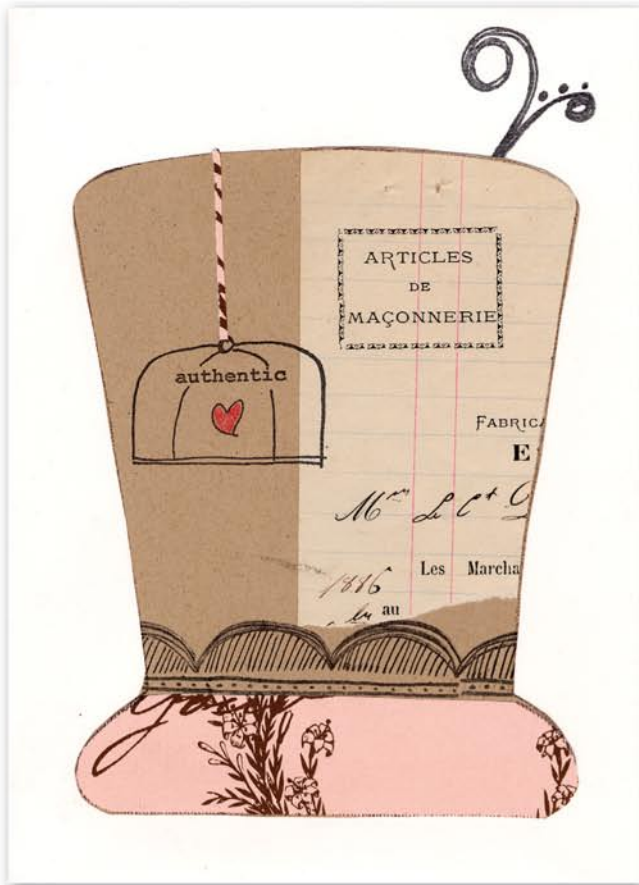


tempting template
