# Tempting Template



**Photograph** • 5¼" x 3¼"

**Devon Warren • Huntington Beach, CA**

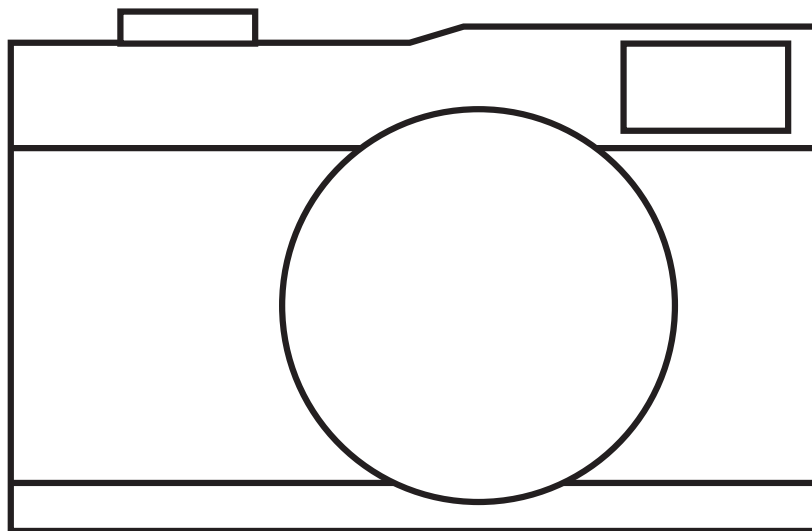
Cut out camera template from kraft cardstock and patterned paper, ink edges, and assemble to make card. Stamp scalloped circle onto card. Stamp scalloped circle again onto patterned paper, cut out, and adhere to card with pop dots. Stamp scalloped circle again onto coordinating patterned paper, cut out circle, and adhere to card. Trim word sticker, ink edges, and adhere to card. Highlight with glitter glue.

**Supplies** Ink: Ganache (Tsukineko - StazOn). Paper: patterned (Prima Marketing). Accents: glitter glue (Ranger - Stickers); ChitChat Stickers (Advantus - Idea-ology)

## Template Instructions

1. Photocopy template
2. Cut out camera
3. Stamp, decorate, and embellish pieces as desired
