Tempting Template



Matcha Tea Magic • 3½" x 6½"

Krystyl Cullins • Costa Mesa, CA

Cut out latte glass template from kraft cardstock to make card. Cut out glass components from mulberry paper, ink edges, and adhere to card with pop dots. Stamp sentiment onto kraft cardstock, cut out, and adhere to card with pop dots. Cut out pieces of whipped topping from couch sheets, layer, and adhere each layer to card with pop dots, creating a three-dimensional effect. Highlight with glitter glue. Adhere bow sticker.

Supplies Stamp: sentiment (Ranger - Dina Wakley Media). Ink: Chai Tea (Tsukineko - StazOn). Paper: mulberry (Graphic Products Corporations - Black Ink); couch sheets (Arnold Grummer's). Accent: Light Burlap Bow (American Crafts - DIY Shop)



Template Instructions

1. Photocopy template.
2. Cut out glass.
3. Stamp, decorate, and embellish pieces as desired.
